


## Illinois Environmental Disclosure Label Clearview Electric, Inc. DBA Clearview Energy Based on 12 months Ending June 30, 2020

As a certified Alternative Electricity Supplier, Clearview Electric Inc. DBA Clearview Energy is required to provide its customers with Environmental Disclosure information quarterly under Section 16-127 of the Electric Service Customer Choice and Rate Relief Law of 1997 and the Illinois Commerce Commission, 83 Ill. Admin. Code 421.30

The information contained herein provides a breakdown of different electricity generation delivered to our customers through the PJM interconnection.



Average amounts of emissions<sup>1</sup> and amount of nuclear waste per 1000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) produced from known<sup>2</sup> sources for the 12 months ending June 30, 2020.

<sup>1</sup>These figures are reflective of the "PJM System Mix". The PJM System Mix is the collective generation produced within the PJM interconnection, which is the regional transmission organization that maintains safety, reliability, and security of the transmission system and operates an efficient and effective wholesale electric market in 13 states and the District of Columbia.

<sup>2</sup>100% of the total electricity was supplied from the PJM Interconnection and the amounts of emission are known, however the amount of nuclear waste attributable to producing this electricity is not known and is not included in this table.
